Project HEART extends the deadline to submit questionnaires

The office of Israel’s Prime Minister has recommended that Project HEART extend the deadline for individuals to submit Questionnaires into 2012; the new deadline will be announced as soon as it is determined. In the interim, individuals should visit the Project HEART website regularly to check for the announcement of the new deadline to submit Questionnaires. Project HEART officials are encouraging individuals to submit their Questionnaires as soon as possible.

New exhibition: *Last Portrait: Painting for Posterity* presents some 200 portraits from Yad Vashem's Art Collection drawn by 21 artists of varied origins and backgrounds. For many of the subjects, the artists' record of their faces, moments before death, is their final portrait. Each portrait joins together three stories: the artist's, the subjects', and that of the work itself. Wherever possible the special circumstances are noted in which the portraits were made and how the artist succeeded in procuring art supplies despite the severe shortages of basic necessities.

A new traveling exhibition chronicling stories of children during the Holocaust, *A Monument of Good Deeds: Dreams and Hopes of Children During the Holocaust*, officially opened at UN Headquarters in New York City on 26 January 2012 and will be on display through February 27, 2012. The exhibit is intended for a younger audience, educating them about the Holocaust through the perspective of children just like them. The exhibition is based on the idea of an empty classroom, with the stories displayed on 13 "chalkboards", some offering interactive experiences, enabling hands-on participation.

The *Keeping the Memory Alive* exhibition features 16 entries of the Design Student Poster Contest, and was displayed at UN Headquarters and all 73 UN Public Information offices around the globe on January 27, 2012. Pioneered by the International School for Holocaust Studies, the project is supported by the Task Force for International Cooperation on Holocaust Education, Remembrance and Research (ITF) in partnership with Yad Vashem, Le Mémorial de la Shoah (France), and the European Shoah Legacy Institute (Czech Republic).

The winners of the 2011 **Yad Vashem International Book Prize for Holocaust Research** in memory of Holocaust survivor Abraham Meir Schwarzbaum and his family members murdered in the Holocaust, are Prof. Christopher Browning (University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill) for *Remembering Survival: Inside a Nazi Slave-Labor Camp*, and Prof. Daniel Blatman (Hebrew University) for *The Death Marches: The Final Phase of Nazi Genocide*.
